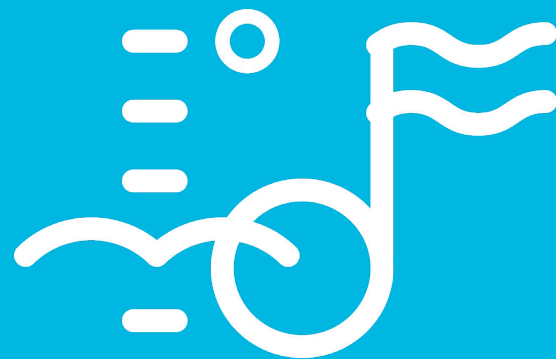

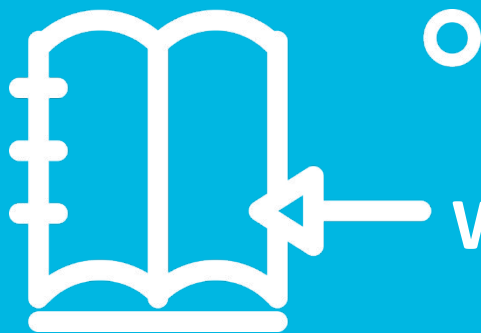

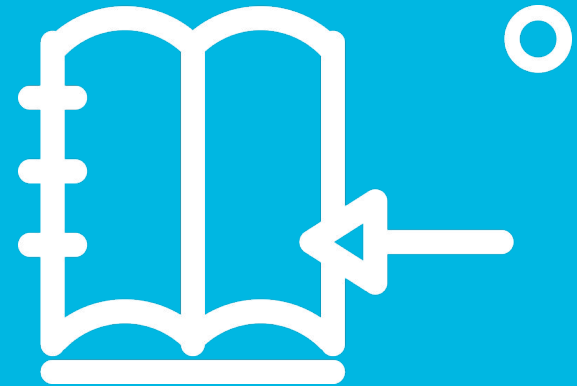
Why study in Slovenia?

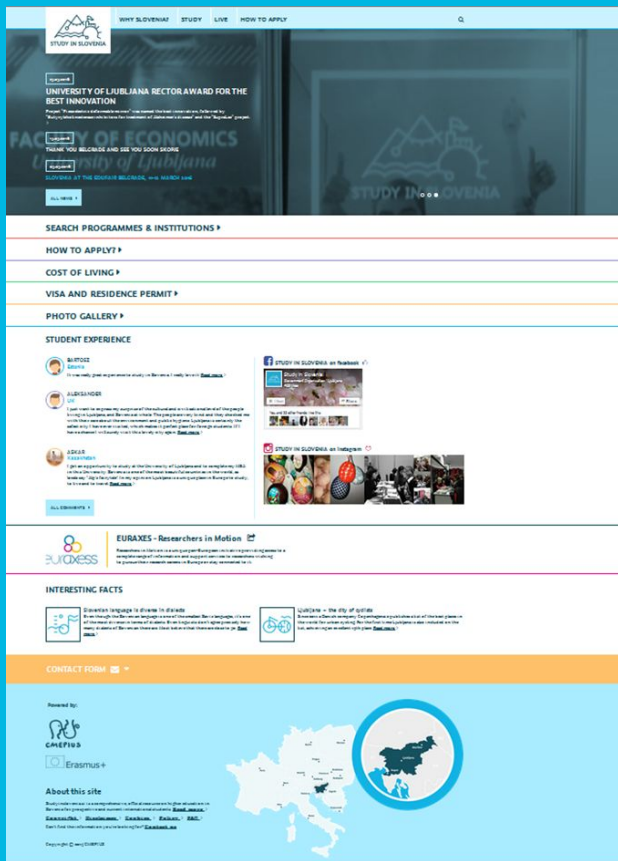
1. Excellent ratio between quality of study and fees

Slovenian higher education system

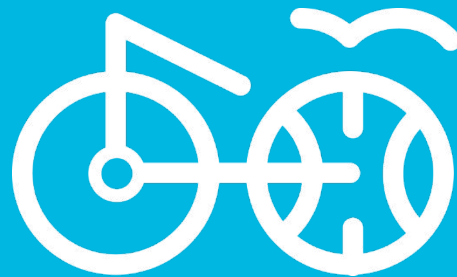

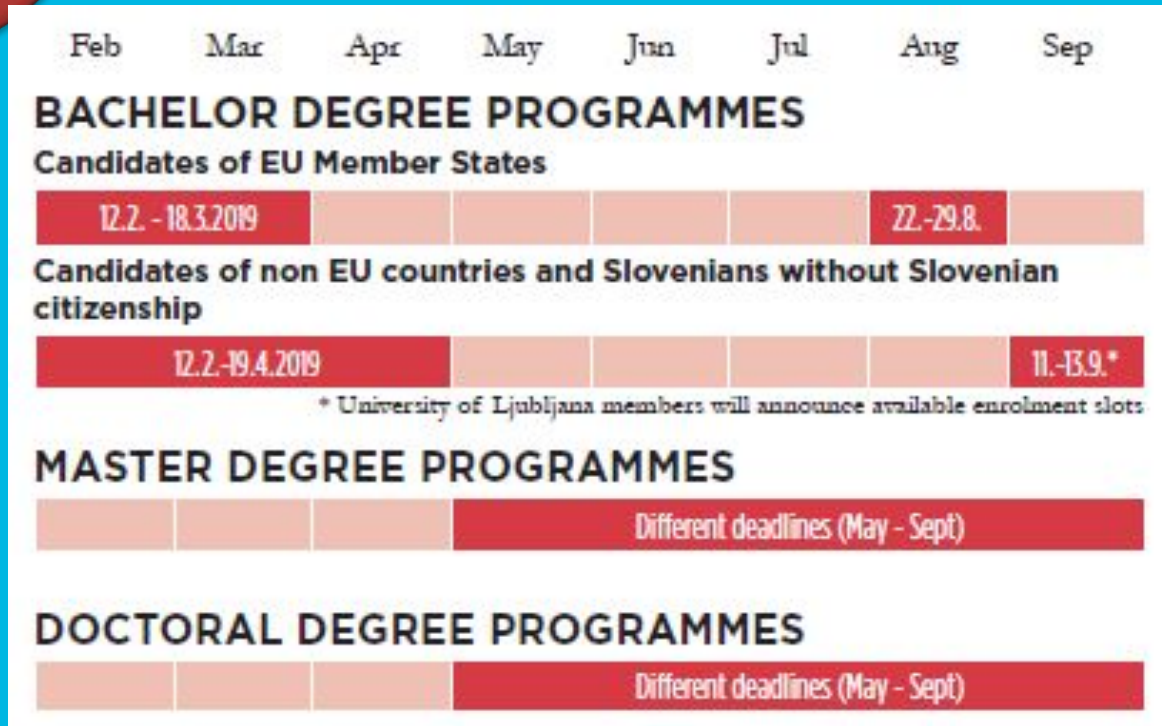

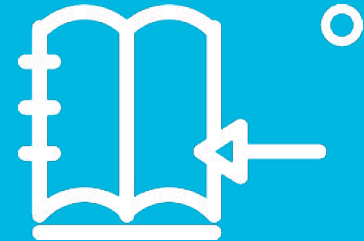
- Second largest university;

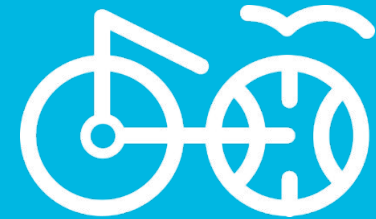
EU members: until **March 30th 2018** (1st application period), **August 22nd-29th 2018** (2nd application period).

Non-EU members: until **April 20th 2018** (1st application period), **September 12th-14th 2018** (2nd application period).

Postgraduate study

EU members: until **September 10th 2018** (just one application period)

Non-EU members: until **May 31st 2018** (1st application period), **July 9th-September 10th 2018** (2nd application period).

Undergraduate: average 2.500 EUR

Masters: average 3.000 EUR

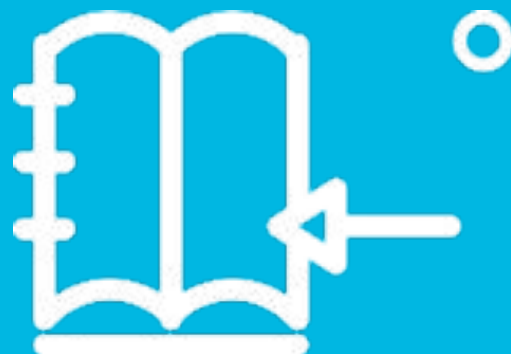

Study in numbers

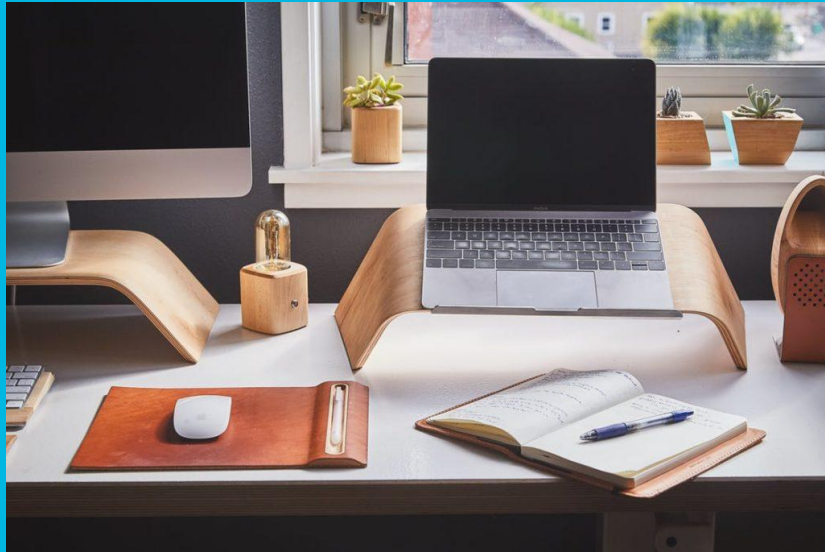
Number of study programmes implemented at UP in the academic year 2019/20 – **80:**

- postgraduate: 1.313





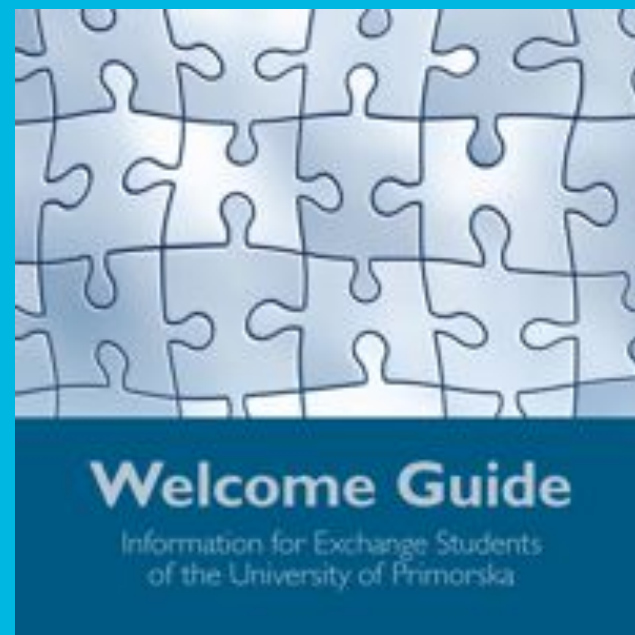
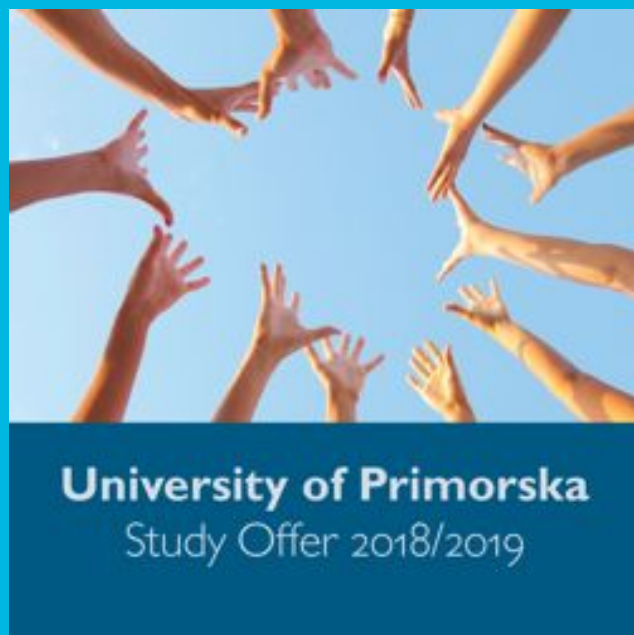

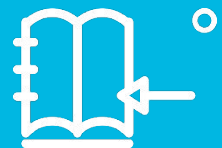

- Safe environment, various opportunities for spending one's leisure time



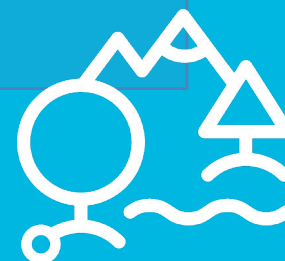
