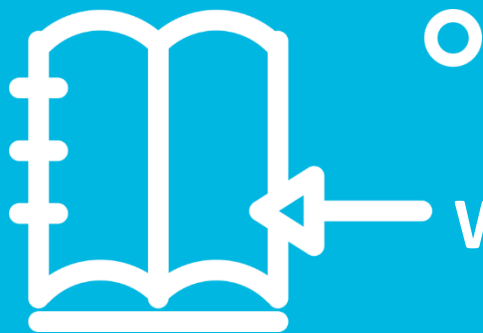

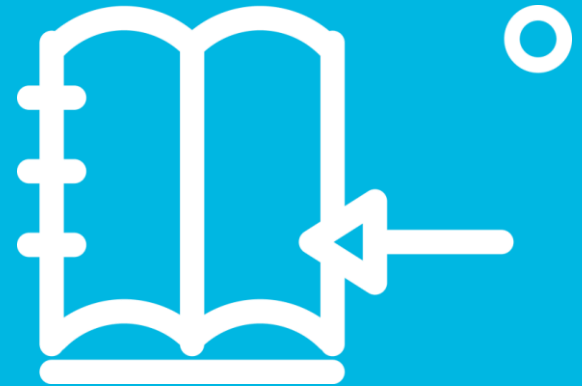
Why study in Slovenia?

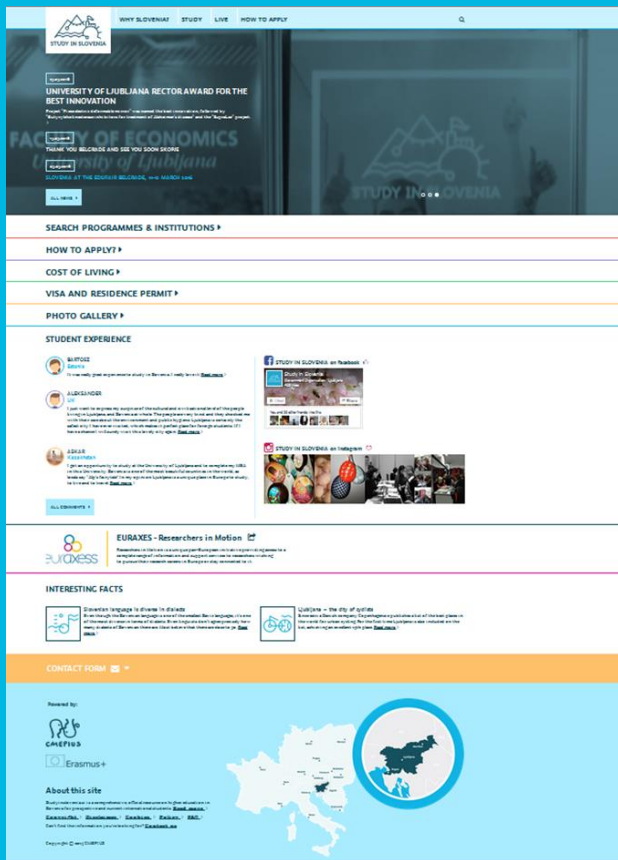
1. Excellent ratio between quality of study and fees

Slovenian higher education system

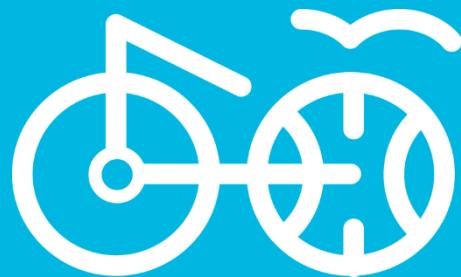
- short-cycle higher vocational education (2-year programmes)

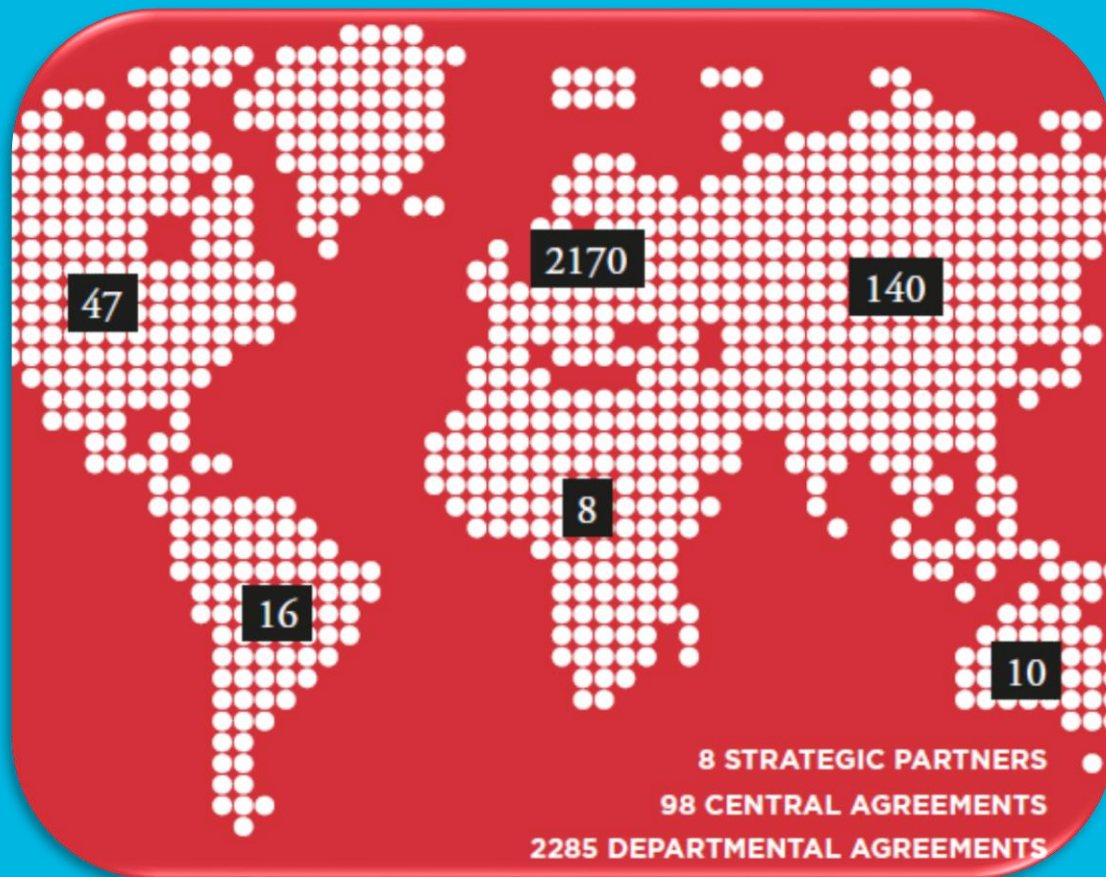

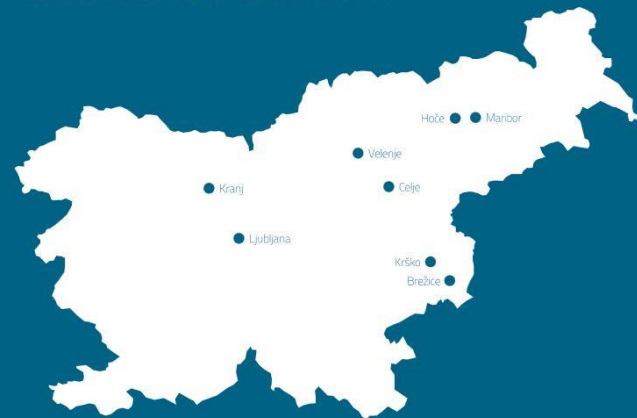

SOME FACTS:

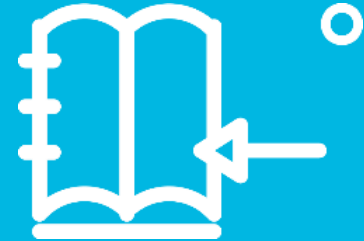
- Second largest university;

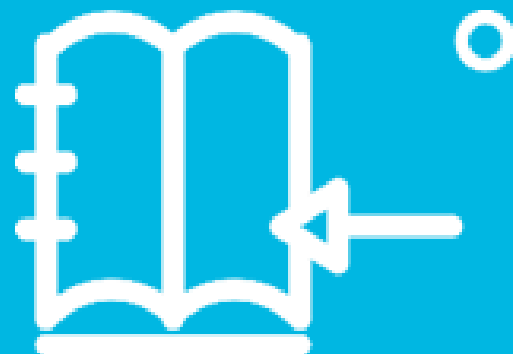

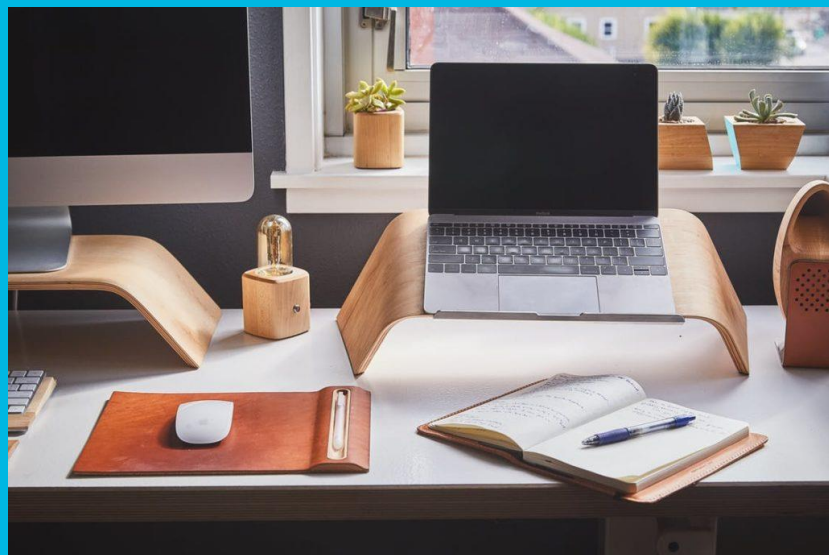
Number of study programmes implemented at UP in the academic year 2017/18 – **78**:

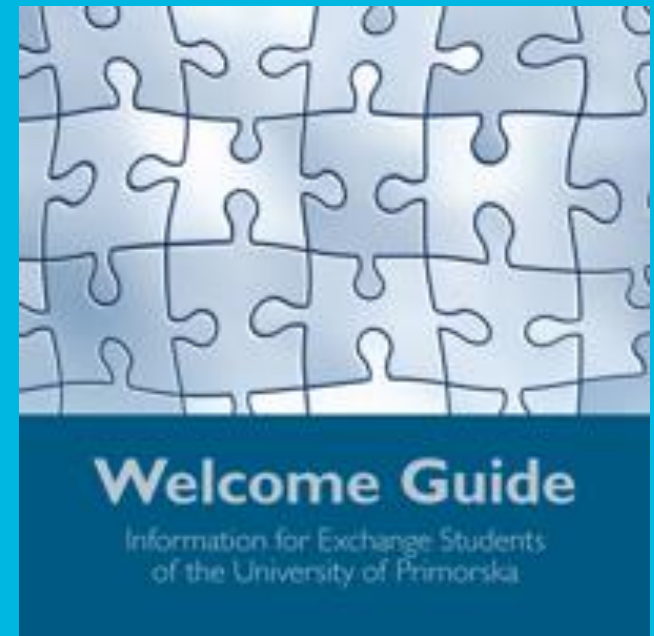
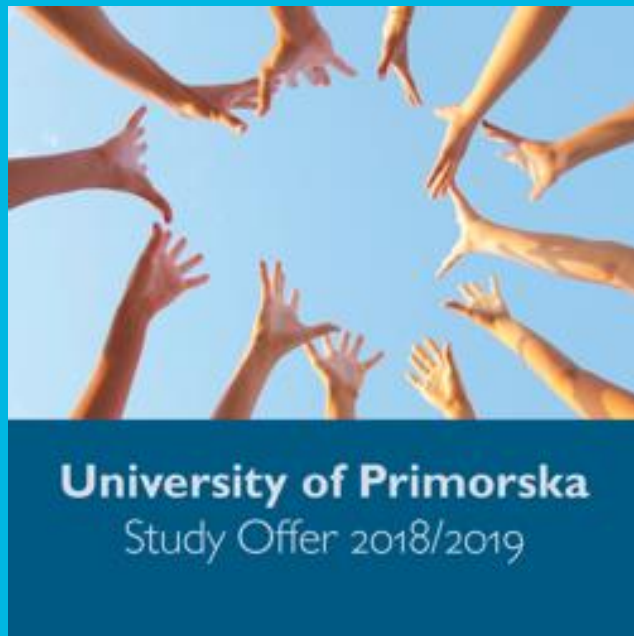
- 30 undergraduate study programmes at 1st cycle,

- postgraduate: 1.353



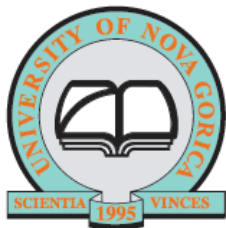

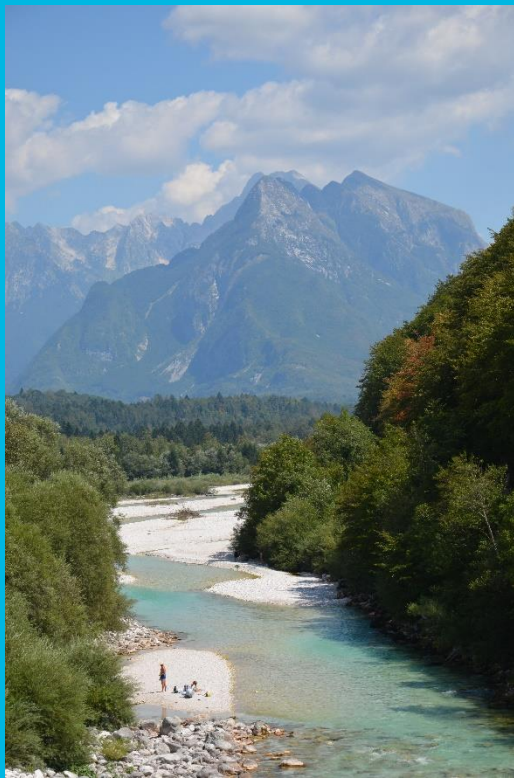

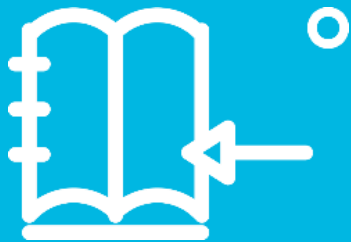


General advantages of studying at UNG

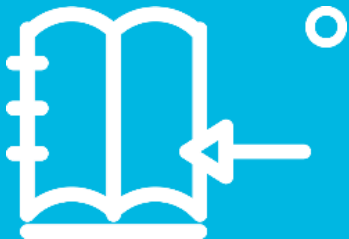

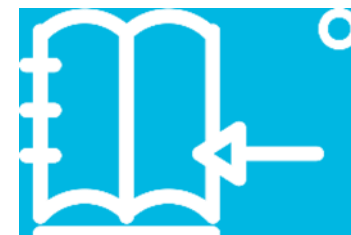
