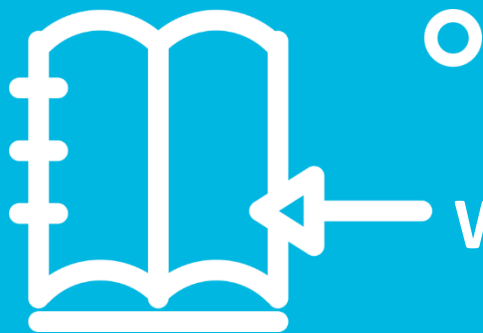

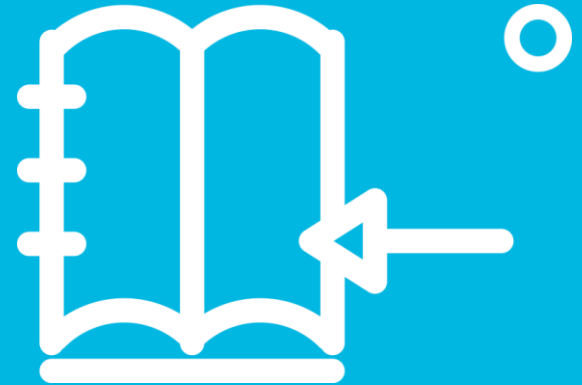
Why study in Slovenia?

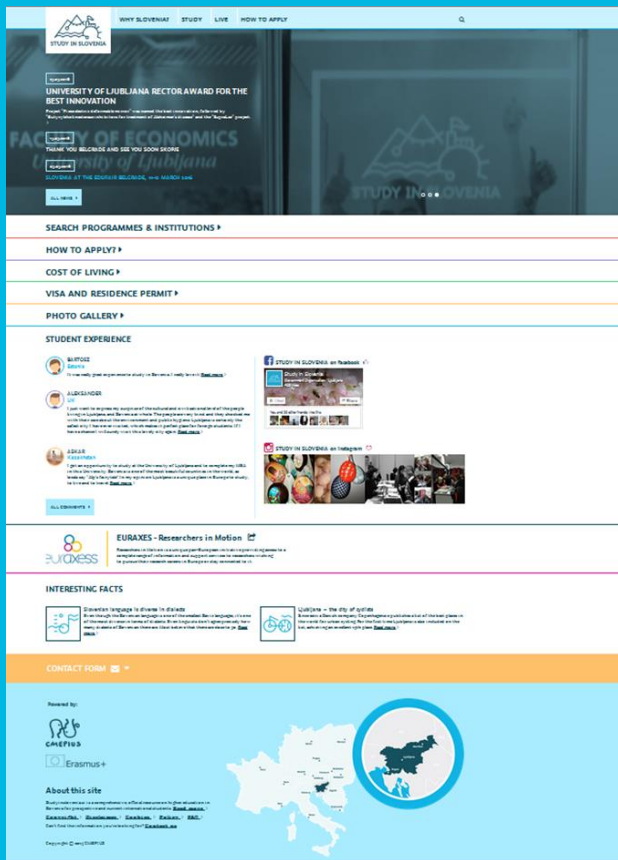
1. Excellent ratio between quality of study and fees

Number of study programmes implemented at UP in the academic year 2017/18 – **78**:

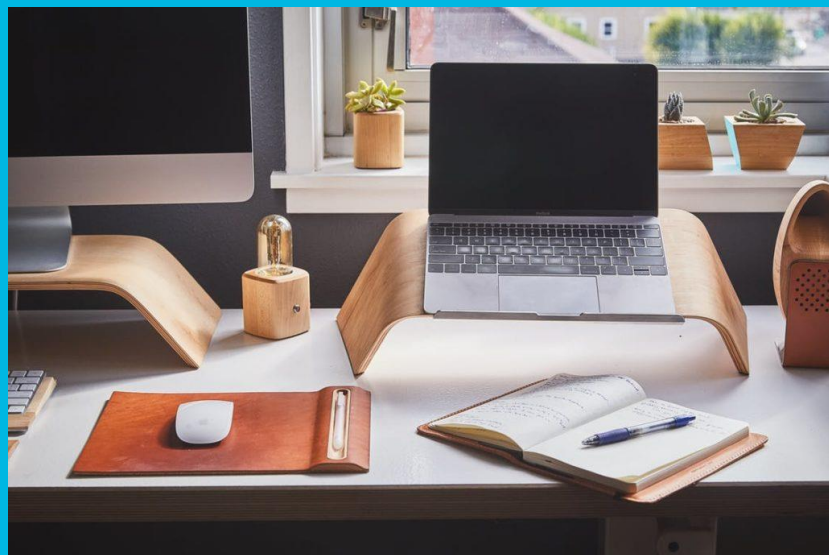
