



CALL FOR ENROLMENT – expected in February APPLICATION PERIODS– expected in December APPLICATION – if ACCEPTED - ENROLMENT

- National online system for enrolment and recognition of foreign education
- Matura or diploma is not required for applying, but it is required for enrolling
- Without using a qualified digital certificate or AAI account (with a username and password) - application is considered if submitted through eVŠ before the deadline as defined in the relevant call for enrolment, and if printed, signed and sent by **registered mail** to the address in the top left corner of the printed application form before the deadline as defined in the relevant call for enrolment
- The required supplements must be sent by registered mail (you will receive letter with requested documents after application)

### Fee is paid by:

- Citizens of non-EU countries, excluding persons with international protection, applicants for international protection and persons from countries with which the Republic of Slovenia has concluded bilateral agreement
- All students with already acquired equivalent degree of education

- All part-time students



### Who does not pay fee (bachelor & master study)?

- Students from EU countries
- Students from countries with which the RS has concluded bilateral agreement (Slovenia has concluded bilateral agreements with Bosnia and Herzegovina, Northern Macedonia, Montenegro, Kosovo and Serbia)
- Scholarship holders of the RS

- Persons granted international protection, applicants for international protection

# MARIBOR: Did you know ...?



**STARA TRTA**: "Žemetovka", the red Slovenian wine grape variety, is the queen of all grapevines, located in the old part of Maribor, beside the River Drava. It is over 400 years old and listed in the Guinness book of records! It is the only plant with its own museum in the Old Vine House!

**THE FIRST ELECTRIC BULB IN SLOVENIA:** It was lit on 4<sup>th</sup> April 1883 in Maribor, only four years after T. A. Edison invented and got a patent for the light-bulb with a carbon filament in the USA.

**RAILWAY CONNECTION VIENNA–TRIESTE**: Maribor experienced strong economic development mid-18<sup>th</sup> century, when it became one of the first in Europe to receive an important railway connection between Vienna and Trieste.

**FESTIVAL LENT:** The Lent International Summer Festival is a major arts festival held for approximately two weeks at the end of June annually in Maribor, Slovenia. It attracts theatre, opera, ballet performers, classical, modern, and jazz musicians and dancers from all over the world as well as visitors! It's worth visiting!



## MARIBOR: Did you know ...?



**WINE CELLAR**: Slovenians surely love their wine! The Maribor city centre hosts one of the largest and oldest classical wine cellars in Europe! The oldest part of the cellar spreading over 15,000 m<sup>2</sup> and boasting 2.1 km long underground passages was built in 1847. Wooden barrels, concrete tankers, bottles with wine patina, etc. have a total capacity of 3 million litres!

**STADIUM "LJUDSKI VRT"**: In Maribor, football matches take place at the stadium "Ljudski vrt". Its notable feature includes the main stand 129,8 m long and 18,4 m high concrete arch that is protected by the Institute for the Protection of Cultural Heritage of Slovenia as an architectural and historical landmark. Violet is the sacred colour of Maribor Football Club! However, if you wear green during the match, stand closer to the exit.





**LEON ŠTUKELJ:** He was a Yugoslav gymnast of Slovene ethnicity, Olympic gold medalist and athlete. His 100<sup>th</sup> birthday in 1998 was a major celebration in Slovenia. Štukelj still exercised regularly even just before he passed away. He is the longest living individual Olympic gold medalist! The University Sports Hall situated on the campus of the University of Maribor is named after him.

No entrance exams, except the proof of ability at the School of Arts. Admission criteria for individual programmes: check <u>www.ung.si</u>

Free Slovenian language course (as an elective course)

Language of instruction: Bachelor's and Master's levels: according to the Slovenian legislation - Slovenian, but extra support in English PhD level: generally English

No preliminary knowledge of Slovenian required, although any preliminary knowledge of Slovenian is an advantage.
